BOTH SIDES, NOW **Interactive play and workshops to inspire** **meaningful end-of-life conversations**

BOTH SIDES, NOW is a unique multi-year community engagement project about living well and leaving well.

Our team spent the past year getting to know the communities in Chong Pang and Telok Blangah with a series of arts-based activities and events that sought to inspire reflections about end-of-life (EOL) issues. We wrapped up the year with a puppetry performance “The Wind Came Home”, about an elderly couple coping with illness and loss. The show was well-received by residents and prompted many heartfelt post-show conversations among audience members. We also reached out to new audience segments with our first Malay and Tamil stagings of this performance.

In 2018, we continue to build on the connections we have forged in these two neighbourhoods, bringing EOL conversations into the heart of these communities.
